EISTEDDFOD YR URDD, CEREDIGION YN YMESTYN DROS DDENG NIWRNOD

Bydd gŵyl ieuenctid fwyaf Ewrop, Eisteddfod Genedlaethol yr Urdd yn ymestyn dros ddeng niwrnod y flwyddyn nesaf yng Ngheredigion o'i gymharu â saith niwrnod yng Nghaerdydd eleni, gyda digwyddiadau gyda'r nos yn cychwyn brynhawn Gwener, 27ain o Fai.

Ieuenctid yr ardal fydd yn cychwyn bwrlwm yr Eisteddfod brynhawn Gwener, gyda pherfformiad o sioe gerdd wedi ei chomisiynu'n arbennig ar gyfer yr ŵyl dan gyfarwyddyd Jeremy Turner a Theatr Arad Goch. Fe fydd yr ieuenctid, sef disgyblion ysgolion uwchradd ardal Ceredigion yn perfformio yn Theatr Felin-fach hyd nos Fawrth, 1af o Fehefin.

Daw clo i'r digwyddiadau nos Sul, 6ed o Fai gyda Chymanfa Ganu a gynhelir yng Nghapel Tabernacl Aberaeron. Bydd y cystadlu yn parhau fel arfer – yn cychwyn fore Llun ac yn gorffen nos Sadwrn – a'r maes ar agor i gyd-fynd â'r cystadlu.

“Rydym wedi penderfynu cychwyn y gweithgareddau nos ynghynt yn 2010,” medd Aled Siôn, Cyfarwyddwr Eisteddfod Genedlaethol yr Urdd. “Yn wahanol i eleni yng Nghaerdydd, mae gennym sioe gynradd yn ogystal â sioe i ddisgyblion yr ysgolion uwchradd. Er mwyn sicrhau fod modd i bawb weld yr holl gyngherddau a pherfformiadau, rydym am lwyfannu'r sioe ieuenctid o'r dydd Gwener cyn i'r 'maes' agor.

“Rydym hefyd wedi sicrhau fod yr ieuenctid yn perfformio ar ddechrau'r ŵyl gan sicrhau y byddant yn rhydd i gystadlu ddiwedd yr wythnos,” ychwanegodd Aled Siôn.

“Er mai dim ond megis dechrau mis Rhagfyr yw hi, rydym yn disgwyl wythnos brysur iawn wrth i ni ryddhau tocynnau ar gyfer digwyddiadau'r dydd a thocynnau maes yfory, 1af o Ragfyr.”

Bydd plant ysgolion cynradd Ceredigion yn dathlu bywyd a gwaith un o awduron plant mwyaf toreithiog a phoblogaidd Cymru. Bu T Llew Jones, fu farw ddechrau'r flwyddyn, yn athro mewn ysgolion cynradd yng Ngheredigion am 35 o flynyddoedd a dros wythnos yr Eisteddfod bydd ei fywyd a'i waith yn dod yn fyw, drwy gyfrwng sioe gerdd newydd sbon a gomisiynwyd ar gyfer yr ŵyl.

Dwynwen Lloyd Evans a'i thîm o Theatr Felinfach fydd wrth y llyw wrth i'r plant baratoi ar gyfer y perfformiadau ym mhafiliwn yr Eisteddfod nos Fawrth, 1af a nos Fercher yr 2il o Fehefin.

“Rydym eisoes wedi cael nifer o gyfarfodydd i drafod syniadau posib ar gyfer y sioe,” medd Dwynwen sy'n hen law ar gyfarwyddo cynrychiadau mawr, cymunedol ac yn edrych ymlaen at ei sialens ddiweddaraf. “Unwaith i ni gwblhau'r tîm o ysgrifenyddwyr, fydd yn cynnwys dramodwyr ac awduron talentog, lleol bydd y gwaith o sgriptio yn cychwyn o ddifri.

“Mae dathlu gwaith un o'n awduron lleol, un oedd mor dalentog ac yn ffigwr poblogaidd drwy'r wlad wedi bod yn ddyhead o'r cychwyn,” meddai Dwynwen. “Wedi marwolaeth T Llew Jones yn

gynharach eleni roedd yna ymdeimlad cryf fod angen creu rhywbeth i anrhydeddu ei waith a'i gyfraniad."

Bydd y Cyngerdd Agoriadol yn y Pafiliwn, nos Sul 30ain o Fai yn agoriad teilwng i'r wyl gyda pherfformiadau gan artistiaid lleol a chenedlaethol. Mae'r Cyngerdd yn argoeli'n noson wefreiddiol fydd yn esgor ar wythnos wych o berfformiadau.

URDD NATIONAL EISTEDDFOD EXTENDED AT CEREDIGION

Europe's largest youth festival, the Urdd National Eisteddfod is to be extended to ten days next year in Ceredigion. This is in comparison to the seven day festival held in Cardiff earlier this year.

The area's youngsters will kick-start the proceedings on Friday afternoon, 27th May with a performance of a specially-commissioned show under the direction of Jeremy Turner and Theatr Arad Goch. The youngsters, all pupils at Ceredigion's secondary schools will be performing at Theatr Felin-fach until Tuesday, 1st of June.

The Eisteddfod will draw to a close on Sunday, 6th of May with a Cymanfa Ganu, held at the Tabernacl Chapel in Aberaeron.

The competitions will remain unchanged – starting on Monday morning and finishing on Saturday evening – with the 'maes' open to coincide with the competitions.

"We've decided to kick –off the evening performances before the Eisteddfod starts in earnest," said Aled Siôn. "Next year there will be a junior and secondary school performance, which differs from this year when the Eisteddfod was in Cardiff. To ensure everyone has a chance to see the shows and concerts, the first performance will be on the Friday before half term week.

"We've also ensured that the older performers will be taking part at the beginning of the festival, giving them time to compete at the end of the week," added Aled Siôn.

"Even though it's only the beginning of December, we're looking forward to a busy week as tickets are released for the 'maes' as well as the evening performances on December 1st."

Primary school children from Ceredigion will be paying homage to one of Wales' most prolific and inspiring children's authors at next year's Urdd National Eisteddfod in Llanerchaeron. T Llew Jones, a primary school teacher in Ceredigion for 35 years, died earlier this year and the Eisteddfod week will see his life and works come alive in a musical extravaganza commissioned especially for the Eisteddfod.

Dwynwen Lloyd Evans and her team at Theatr Felinfach will be leading the children from local primary schools across the county as they tread the Eisteddfod pavilion's boards on Tuesday, 1st and Wednesday, 2nd of June.

"We've already sat around the table and discussed possible ideas for the show," said Dwynwen who has directed many large, community productions in the past and is looking forward to her latest challenge. "Once we've finalised our team of writers, which will consist of local, talented dramatists and authors, we'll start working on the script.

"There's been an aspiration from the start to work on something to celebrate one of our most cherished local authors, who is loved nationally. T Llew Jones died earlier this year and everyone involved in the production feels this is a great way to honour his work," she continued.

The Opening Concert at the Pavilion on Sunday, 30th May will be a fitting start to the festival with local and national talent on show in what promises to be a fantastic spectacle to mark the beginning of a wonderful week of performances.
