

How to get to the Urdd Eisteddfod Maes 2012

The Urdd Eisteddfod Maes 2012 is situated near Glynllifon College about 6 miles from Caernarfon on the A499 to Pwllheli.

If traveling from Bangor, take the A487 out of Caernarfon. After going through the villages of Bontnewydd and Dinas take the A499 from Llanwnda roundabout towards Pwllheli.

For those coming from the south, follow the A487 from Porthmadog to Caernarfon and then follow the signs for the Eisteddfod from the roundabout, that will take you to the Maes.

Look for the yellow signs that will lead you towards the car park entrance through a new entrance to the college grounds. The normal arch entrance will not be open during the Eisteddfod. It is vital that everyone follow the signs to ensure that traffic flows smoothly.

There will also be a shuttle bus service from Caernarfon and Pwllheli. Further details below. Check the Eisteddfod website for regular updates.

Special Arriva Bus Services during the Eisteddfod Week

During the week, Arriva will provide a special bus service **every half hour** from Monday to Saturday:

- Caernarfon Bus Station to the Eisteddfod Maes in Glynllifon between 09:30 – 17:30
- Eisteddfod Maes in Glynllifon to Caernarfon Bus Station between 10:00 - 18:00
- Pwllheli Bus Station to the Eisteddfod Maes in Glynllifon between 09:20 - 16:55
- Eisteddfod Maes in Glynllifon to Pwllheli Bus Station between 10:00 - 17:35

A special bus stop will be located within easy walking distance to the Eisteddfod's Main Entrance for dropping off and picking up passengers. A small charge will be required for using this service.
